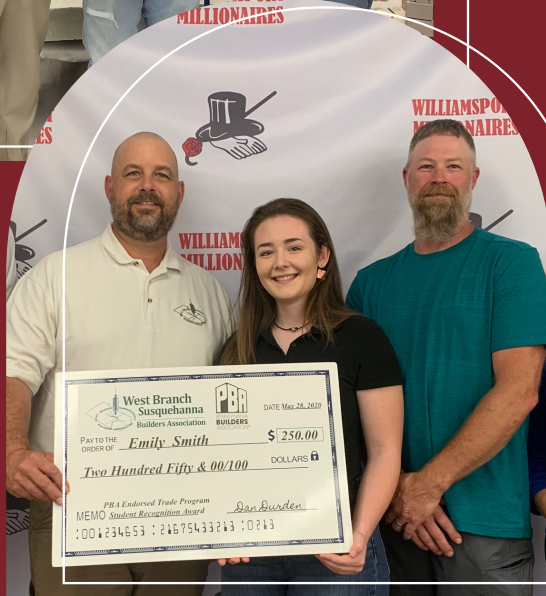

# BENEFITS

PBA's Endorsed Trade Program promotes quality and industry recognition to students, parents, employers, policy makers, and the general public.

Your involvement with PBA will help form important partnerships with local builders and connect you with industry leading resources helping to ensure workforce-ready individuals.

With more than 4,000 members, no other building organization in Pennsylvania represents such a large and diverse segment of the home building industry.

Secondary students who obtain a competent or advanced on the NOCTI exam will receive a PBA Skills Certificate (PDE Industry Recognized Certificate), and can be listed on the website for employment purposes.

ETP partners receive a certificate from PBA recognizing the endorsement. The certificate may be displayed in the school.

Granting of PBA's endorsement authorizes the school to publicize the designation. Schools may use information about PBA's endorsement and the PBA logo in their promotional efforts.

Endorsed Trade Program & NAHB Chapter students will be eligible for grants and scholarships.
